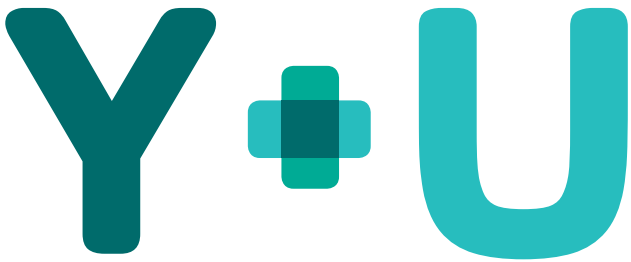

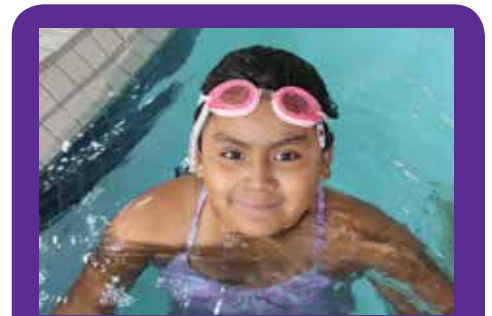

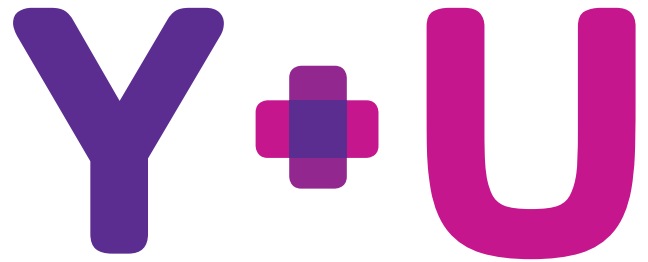
**Make-A-Splash poster child**

Through the generosity of our volunteers and donors, we are able to ensure that everyone in our community has the opportunity to participate in the Y's incredible programs.

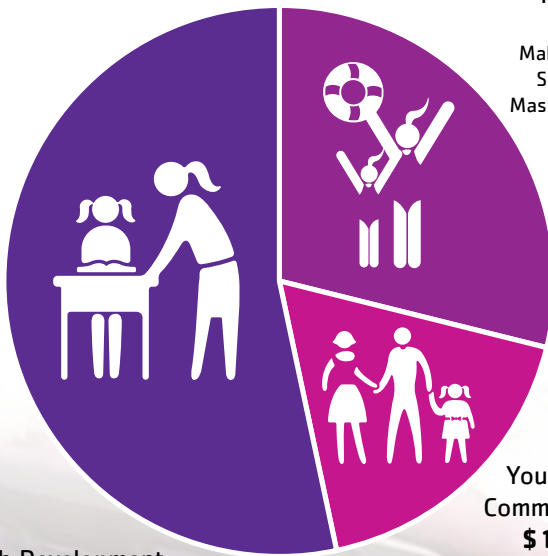

The Wood River Community YMCA is a non-profit organization. The Y is governed by an independent volunteer Board of Directors.

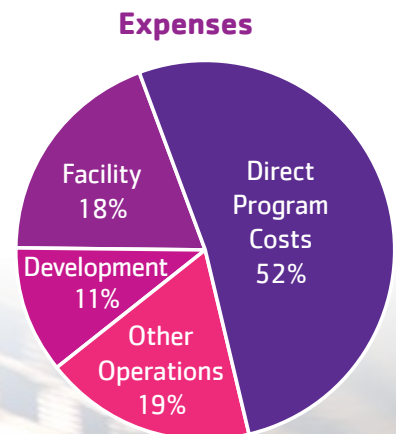
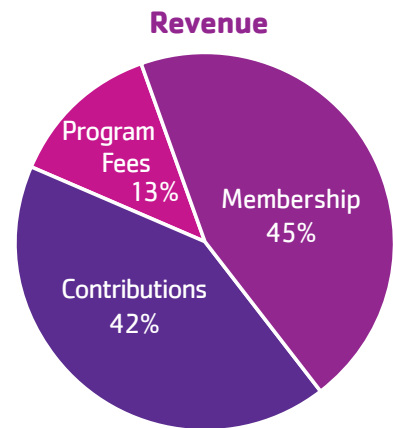

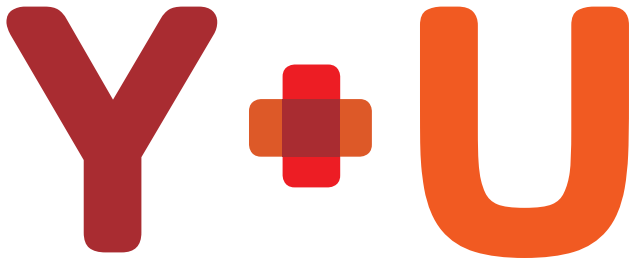
